Members of the Paul Harris Society contribute \$US1,000 or more each year to the Annual Fund, PolioPlus Fund, or approved global grants.



District Management

You are invited to become a Rotary Centurion or Member of the Paul Harris Society as a first step in making the Rotary Foundation your charity of choice:

1. Complete the application form on the last page and email it to PDG Murray Compton murraycompton8@gmail.com or print and mail it to Centurion Manager, PO Box 8073, Riccarton, Christchurch 8440.
 2. Donate online by direct credit to the Rotary Club of Riccarton Charitable Trust account 03 1355 0516692 003 - ensuring that you enter in "Name/Particulars" your Surname and Initial, and in "Reference" your Club. The Riccarton Trust processes the donations and transfers them monthly to the New Zealand Rotary Clubs Charitable Trust for remitting to TRF (see below). Because banks are phasing out cheques, online banking is the only payment option available.
- Receipts will be provided by email where name and club are supplied.
 - An annual reminder will be sent to all Centurions Paul Harris Society Members at the beginning of the Rotary year. You do not need to action that as soon as you get the reminder, and may prefer to schedule that for some other date. or by automatic payment

The Fine Print

Donations to The Rotary Foundation are invested by TRF and then applied in full three years later to various projects. Administration is funded by the income from the three year investment. All projects are under the direct supervision of Rotarians

Donations to the Rotary Foundation are tax-deductible in New Zealand if they are made through the New Zealand Rotary Clubs Charitable Trust. This is one of a few select trusts that have the right to remit money overseas but still offer charitable donations receipts in NZ that are eligible for a tax rebate (Donations made online via the Rotary International website are NOT tax deductible in New Zealand).

Unless specified otherwise, donations made via the NZRC Charitable Trust will be directed to the Rotary Foundation's "Annual Fund" where they will count toward both the SHARE programme and Paul Harris recognition. If you want your donation to go to other than the

Annual Fund, advise PDG Murray Compton. Details on the Foundation's various giving programmes are at <https://my.rotary.org/en/donate> - not all are eligible for PHF recognition.

TRF not only funds projects around the world, but grants are available to our own District for projects here. We have done some very good work with such grants. The amount often attracts additional grants from TRF. That's like doubling the bang for your charitable buck!

Checking Donations

- Individual Rotarians who wish to check their Centurion donor history can do so by logging onto My Rotary and selecting the following options: My Rotary / The Rotary Foundation / Foundation Reports / Donor History Report / View Report.
- Club Secretaries, Club Presidents and Club Foundation Chairs (once registered for these roles on My Rotary) can check on all club members by logging onto My Rotary and selecting the following options: My Rotary / The Rotary Foundation / Foundation Reports / Club Giving / View Reports / Club Recognition Summary. In top left corner of the report select "Members (All values)" to include all donations associated with the Club past and present. The first line of the report shows the Foundation Recognition Pts Available to the Club for awarding as PHFs.
